ORDER:-

In the Government order 1st read above, orders were issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.20.85 lakh towards distribution of prize amounts to State and District Level Winners of Crop Yield Competition for the year 2020-21 and Government also permitted the Director of Agriculture for conducting the State Level and District Level Crop Yield Competition for the year 2021-22 at a cost of Rs.20,85,000/- for which Award could be declared and prize and certificate could be distributed on the eve of Republic Day, 2023.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Director of Agriculture has sent proposal for continuing the Crop Yield Competition at State and District Level during the year 2022-23 and to sanction a sum of Rs.17.90 lakh for conducting 88 Nos. of District Level Competitions and Rs.2.70 lakh for conducting 9 Nos. of State Level Competitions and Rs.25,000/- for tour travel allowance, totaling Rs.20.85 lakh for the year 2021-22 for both District and State Level Competitions so as to achieve the object of Crop Yield Competition.

3. The Director of Agriculture has furnished the details of prize amounts for the crops under State Level and District Level competitions as follows:-

4. Further, the Director of Agriculture has stated that as per guidelines issued in the Government order 1st read above, the last date of harvest for Crop Yield Competition at State and District Level is 30th April 2022 and last date of receipt of final report is 10th May 2022. Award can be declared and prize can be distributed on the Republic Day, 2023.

5. The Director of Agriculture has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for incurring the expenditure of the year 2021-22 at a cost of Rs.20,85,000/- for conducting the State Level and District Level Crop Yield Competition and also orders for conducting the State and District level Crop Yield Competitions 2022-23. Award can be declared and prize and certificate can be distributed on the Republic Day, 2024. He has furnished the physical and Financial Programme for Crop Yield Competition for 2022-23.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Director of Agriculture hereby accord sanction for a sum of Rs.20.85 lakh (Rupees twenty lakh and eighty five thousand only) towards distribution of prize amounts to State and District Level Winners of Crop Yield Competition for the year 2021-22.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2401 – 00 Crop Husbandry – 102 Food grain Crops – State's Expenditure - JD Crop Yield Competition"

(i) 04 Travel Expenses-01 Tour Travelling Allowances (IFHRMS DPC: 2401 00 102 JD 30401)-Rs.0.25 lakh

(ii) 59 Prizes and Awards – 01 Prizes and Awards (IFHRMS DPC: 2401 00 102 JD 35901)-Rs.20.60 lakh

8. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above to the concerned.

9. The Government also permit the Director of Agriculture for conducting the State Level and District Level Crop Yield Competition for the year 2022-23 at a cost of Rs.20,85,000/-. Award can be declared and prize and certificate can be distributed on the eve of Republic Day, 2024. The physical and Financial Programme for Crop Yield Competition for 2022-23 are as follows:-

10. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to allocate district wise target as per guidelines annexed to this order within the overall financial limit so as to achieve the object of Crop Yield Competition.

11. The Application form, Physical Target for State and District Level Competition and Finance allotted are given for 2022-23 in Annexure II to V to this order.

12. The Enrolment Fee for farmers participating in the Crop Yield Competition, will be collected and credited to the following Head of Account:-

"0401-00-Crop Husbandry -800-Other receipts-AJ Crop Yield Competition -237 Sale proceeds -01 Agriculture".

13. The Government permit the Director of Agriculture and the Joint Director of Agriculture of concerned district, to declare the winners for State and District respectively and to draw the Prize amount and distribute the Prizes to the winners.

14. The Government also permit the Director of Agriculture to change the crop under Crop Yield Competition, in the event of monsoon failure, natural disaster and crop not cultivated without exceeding the total financial sanction.

15. The Director of Agriculture is directed to send the list of prize winners of District and State level Crop Yield Competitions to Government.

16. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.38749/Finance (Agriculture and Farmers Welfare)2022, Dated: 12.08.2022.

Guidelines to conduct Crop Yield Competition during 2022-23

1. Minimum of **50 cents** area should be harvested for any category of the crops.
2. State & District level Prizes will be declared based on maximum yield (**with moisture**) obtained on the date of harvest.
3. Competitions for State & District Level should be conducted separately.
4. Both Landowners and lease holders may participate in the competitions.
5. Crop Yield competition will be conducted in the following crops viz., Paddy (Irrigated & Rainfed), Groundnut (Irrigated & Rainfed), Chulam (Irrigated), Cumbu (Irrigated & Rainfed), Maize (Irrigated), Greengram (Irrigated), Blackgram (Irrigated), Redgram (Irrigated), Sugarcane & Cotton (Irrigated). Farmers should participate either in State Level or District Level Competition only.
6. Farmers who enrolled in Special Award for System of Rice Intensification (SRI) (in the same field) should not participate in Crop Yield Competition. Farmers who got prize in Crop Yield Competition District level / State level should not participate in next 3 Financial Years.
7. Enrolment fee for the competition may be collected as detailed below;

Paddy, Groundnut, Sugarcane, Cotton, Chulam , Cumbu,
Maize, Blackgram, Greengram & Redgram

1. State Level Rs.100/-
2. District Level Rs. 50/-

8. The Prize amount for I and II Prize winners are furnished below:-

9. Since high yielding varieties are cultivated in a large scale, minimum yield obtained should be mentioned as below :

1. Paddy (Irrigated)	...	4,000 Kg. /Ac.
2. Paddy (Rainfed)	...	1800 Kg. /Ac.
3. Cholam (Irrigated)	...	1,500 Kg. /Ac.
4. Cumbu (Irrigated)	...	1,200 Kg. /Ac.
5. Cumbu (Rainfed)	...	900 Kg./ Ac.
6. Redgram, Greengram and Blackgram (Irr.)	...	400 Kg. /Ac.
7. Groundnut (Irrigated)	...	2,500 Kg. /Ac.
8. Groundnut (Rainfed)	...	1,000 Kg. /Ac.
9. Maize (Irrigated)	...	2,000 Kg. /Ac.
10. Cotton (Irrigated)	...	6 Qtl. /Ac.
11. Sugarcane	...	50 MT. /Ac.

10. Crop Yield Competition can be conducted in all the Districts except Chennai and the Nilgiris.

11. All the participants should fill up the format prescribed in Annexure II and submit to Assistant Director of Agriculture concerned along with Enrolment fees. Receipt for enrolment fees paid should be given to the participant.

12. **Last date of harvest for Crop Yield Competition at State & District Level for the year 2022-23 is 30th April 2023 and last date of receipt of final report is 10th May 2023. Award can be declared and prize and certificate can be distributed on the eve of Republic Day 2024.**

13. The participant or the representative of the participant should inform the exact harvest date of crop in person or through Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due or over phone to the concerned Assistant Director of Agriculture & get the acknowledgement. Otherwise, the request of farmers will not be entertained and the enrolment fees will not be refunded. Intimation should be sent to the Assistant Director of Agriculture at least 15 days in advance. Participants alone will be held responsible for any postal delay.

14. In the event of monsoon failure, natural disasters & crop not cultivated the specific crop wise Physical target earmarked to districts is not achieved; the Director of Agriculture may be

should be sent to the Assistant Director of Agriculture at least 15 days in advance. Participants alone will be held responsible for any postal delay.

14. In the event of monsoon failure, natural disasters & crop not cultivated the specific crop wise Physical target earmarked to districts is not achieved; the Director of Agriculture may be authorized to re-allot the Physical target within the Financial Allocation.
15. With regard to District Level Competitions, the Assistant Directors of Agriculture concerned will fix the harvest date in consultation with District Joint Directors of Agriculture. With reference to State Level Competitions, the District Joint Directors of Agriculture will fix the harvest date and intimate to the Director of Agriculture well in advance so that a representative will be nominated to attend the harvest.
16. The Competition will be conducted by the following committees. The Committee for the District & State Level Competitions will be constituted as follows. At least any three-committee members should be present during the harvest.

STATE LEVEL:

1. Director of Agriculture (or) his representative
2. District Joint Director of Agriculture (or) Representative other than the Assistant Director of Agriculture of the Block.
3. District Collector (or) his Representative
4. Any one of the three progressive farmers (Approved by District Collectors).

DISTRICT LEVEL:

1. District Joint Director of Agriculture (or) Representative other than the Asst. Director of Agriculture of the Block.
2. District Collector (or) his Representative
3. Assistant Director of Agriculture
4. Any One Asst. Director of Agriculture of the Districts other than the Asst. Director of Agriculture of the Block.
5. Any one of the Three Progressive farmers. (The farmers are selected by the Joint Directors of Agriculture and approved by the District Collectors)

The State & District Level non-official committee constituted by the Director of Agriculture and Collector respectively are treated as I &

II Class Committee for the purpose of tour performed in connection with the Crop Yield Competition.

17. The Crop Yield Competition conducting committee has got rights to reject the competitors who are violating the rules and try to win the prizes in unlawful ways. The committee should inform such type of action taken against these competitors to District Joint Director of Agriculture and Director of Agriculture.
18. The District Level Crop Yield Competition prize winners will be declared by District Joint Directors of Agriculture.
19. The State Level Crop Yield Competition prize winners will be declared by the Director of Agriculture.
20. The District Level Crop Yield Competition prize awards will be drawn by the Joint Directors of Agriculture and distributed to the prize winners by ECS.
21. **The State Level Crop Yield Competition prize awards will be drawn by the Director of Agriculture and distributed to the prize winners as Demand Draft by Director of Agriculture along with certificate.**
22. **The Certificate for District level Crop Yield Competition awards will be distributed to prize winners by elected representatives and District Collectors during the Republic Day.**
23. Any problem relating to the declaration of prizes will be examined by the Crop yield Competition Committee. The committee will take the final decision.
