ORDER:-

In the Government Order 1st read above, an "Information Technology Cadre" with certain posts has been created for the Directorate of e-Governance which is under the administrative control of Information Technology Department and in the Government Order 2nd read above, the IT service rules for the following posts have been framed:-

Assistant System Analyst/ Assistant System Engineer	Rs.9300-34800 + Grade pay 5100 (Rs.37,700-119500, level – 20)

2. In the letter 4th read above, the Secretary, Information Technology Department has stated that, it has been proposed to fill up the 60 entry level posts of Assistant System Engineer / Assistant System Analyst by Direct Recruitment through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Once the candidates are recruited by TNPSC, they shall be deputed to other departments to undertake Information Technology related works and e-Governance activities. The salary and other emoluments for the deputation staff have to be undertaken by the department to which he / she shall be deputed. The qualification and pay scale details for the post of Assistant System Engineer / Assistant System Analyst are specified in the Government Order 2nd read above.

3. The Secretary, Information Technology Department has, therefore, requested to get formal financial / post sanction for the post of Assistant System Engineer (ASE) or Assistant System Analyst (ASA) in respect of Agriculture Department by projecting a matching surrender (or) creation of a new post so as to accommodate the personnel being recruited under "IT Cadre". Accordingly, the Head's of Department under the control of this department have been requested to send a detailed report to Government.

4. In the letter 6th read above, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has informed that Agricultural Engineering Department requires 2 posts of Assistant System Engineers (ASE) to carry out the IT related activities and one Assistant System Engineer will be employed as Server Administrator / Application Developer, another post of Assistant System Engineer will be employed as Network Administrator / IT Assets Maintenance / User Support. He has also furnished the duties and responsibilities of the above posts as follows:-

I. Server Administrator / Application Developer :-

To maintain the two numbers of department servers, placed at Tamil Nadu State Data Centre (TNSDC) along with the maintenance of applications hosted on the servers.

- Monitor and upgrade the Server Operating Systems at regular interval.
- Co-ordinate with TNSDC team to deploy security patches based on the security advices issued by Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), NIC and SDC.
- Monitor the user accounts, logs, renewal of SSL, Monitor the apache file permissions, server load etc.,
- Monitor the database activities and to take backup at regular intervals to avoid data loss.
- Manage / upgrade the web applications hosted on the web server and development of new software modules.

II. Network Administrator / IT Assets Maintenance / User support :-

- He is responsible for maintaining the Agricultural Engineering Department network connectivity including the maintenance of "TNSWAN", IP Phones, etc.,
- He should maintain the IT assets of Agricultural Engineering Department, including new purchase, Annual Maintenance contract, Maintenance of software licence, Open source software support, etc.,

- He should co-ordinate with district officials for the implementation of "IFHRMS", Department Monitoring Information System, data entry, etc.,
- He should be responsible for Local Area Network (LAN), Internet Protocol (IP), Address allocation for sub-ordinate offices of Agricultural Engineering Department.

5. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has further stated that the posts may be filled up by deputing Assistant System Engineers from e-Governance Agency, Chennai and proposed that the 2 posts of Assistant System Engineers are to be filled up at headquarters of Agricultural Engineering Department by projecting a matching surrender of the following two posts so as to accommodate the said personnel being recruited under "IT Cadre":-

The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has, therefore, requested the Government to consider the above proposal and issue necessary orders to employ the two Assistant System Engineers on deputation basis from the Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency, Chennai to carry out the IT related activities in the Agricultural Engineering Department by surrendering two posts of Assistant Engineer / Junior Engineer in Agricultural Engineering department.

7. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and accordingly, issue orders for creation of two posts of Assistant System Analyst / Assistant System Engineer in the Office of the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) in lieu of surrendering of existing two posts of Assistant Engineer / Junior Engineer at the Office of the Assistant Executive Engineer (AED) at Viruthachalam & Vasudevanallur and permit to employ the above two Assistant System Analyst / Assistant System Engineers as ordered in Government Order first read above on deputation basis from the Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency, Chennai to carry out the IT related activities in the Agricultural Engineering Department.

8. The Expenditure for the above newly created posts shall be debited to the following head of account:-
